

How to create an App Password for a Gmail account

First log into your Gmail account.

Then click on your account symbol in the upper right corner and select, Manage your Google Account.




Then select Security from the let pane.




2-Step Verification needs to be on to set up an App Password.

Select App passwords.



It will then make you log into your Gmail account for authorization.

Select the drop down for Select App and choose Other (Custom name)




Then go ahead and name the App whatever you would like. For example (Ricoh)

Then hit Generate.

← App passwords

App passwords let you sign in to your Google Account from apps on devices that don't support 2-Step Verification. You'll only need to enter it once so you don't need to remember it. Learn more



This will then create a special password for you to use with your Gmail account to allow the copier to authenticate with Gmail.

Generated app password Fupt yqe How to use it Go to the settings the application of up. Replace your character password Just like your nor password grants Google Account. it, so don't write it anyone.

Your app password for your device

Go to the settings for your Google Account in the application or device you are trying to set up. Replace your password with the 16-character password shown above.

Just like your normal password, this app password grants complete access to your Google Account. You won't need to remember it, so don't write it down or share it with anyone.

DONE

This generates this password one time and you will not be able to retrieve it once you hit the Done button.

Please write it down or copy and paste it into the machine for use.

If you forget the password, you will need to generate a new one.
